- I. Welcome, Jon Mark Buckner - President
 - Introductions and review of Mission and Purpose.
- II. Waco Animal Birth Control Clinic Representative, Sabrina Dyer
 - Services include pharmacy, trap/return, pet food pantry services, outreach team, heartworm testing, and more. Valley Mills and Clay.
 - Trap and return of cats (feral/residence) that spend primary time outdoors. Cats picked up, neutered/spayed, and returned to reduce the number of cats over time. Contact them for any cat population issues.
 - Neighborhood issue with squirrels and connection to cats. Notice of fox in area by Lake Air (animal control concern). Resident not able to take care of animals (ABC can help support them- be sure to contact). Cats that comes in yard, ABC can come into the area, ask neighbors, and see how they can help.
- III. Grant Acceptance & Next Steps
 - Review of awarded grant for neighborhood signage. Awaiting city signatures to hire consulting team/artist and buying new signs. Need map of old signs for replacement (est. 14). Can proceed with design efforts before finalized.

 - Committee for neighborhood events need. Event at park with hot dogs presented. No food permit needed but would need a sign-in and highlight to members only or residents to join. Had volunteers for the committee to begin planning.
